1. Why do I need an executive protection agent?

You want the best attorney, doctor, and accountant. You should also have the best executive protection [EP] agent responsible for the safety of you and your family.

2. Why not hire off-duty law enforcement officers?

Most law enforcement officers have little or no executive protection training. Their academy training focuses on responding to crimes after they occur and to subsequently apprehend criminals. It is reactive; executive protection is preventive.

3. Why not hire a guard or uniformed security officer?

A security guard lacks the training of a qualified EP agent. Security guards complete only 40 hours of training, and their primary responsibility is to observe and report.

4. What distinguishes The World Protection Group, Inc.®?

Our EP agents employ the same professional standards as the U.S. Secret Service, the best in the executive protection/threat management industry. They meet all Bureau of Security & Investigative Services licensing requirements and hold the following permits: Security Guard/Bodyguard, Firearms, Baton, and Tear Gas/Pepper Spray. 6. How would EP agents integrate at a residence or corporate property?

A site survey at the property assesses general and specific threats facing your family or company. The threats determine the number of agents needed. They would include a handpicked detail leader and agents, and carry a job-specific security manual with post orders and emergency and fire procedures.

7. Do I need an intrusion-detection system?

Yes — in most cases. This minimizes the number of EP agents needed. We combine high-quality personnel and an electronic intrusion detection system that meets your needs and budget.

8. Will 24-hour protection intrude on privacy?

WPG EP agents are discreet and have little interaction with the family.

9. Do you offer other services, such as the ability to investigate, collect intelligence on, and neutralize potential threats?
